November 1, 2017 in Odessa.*

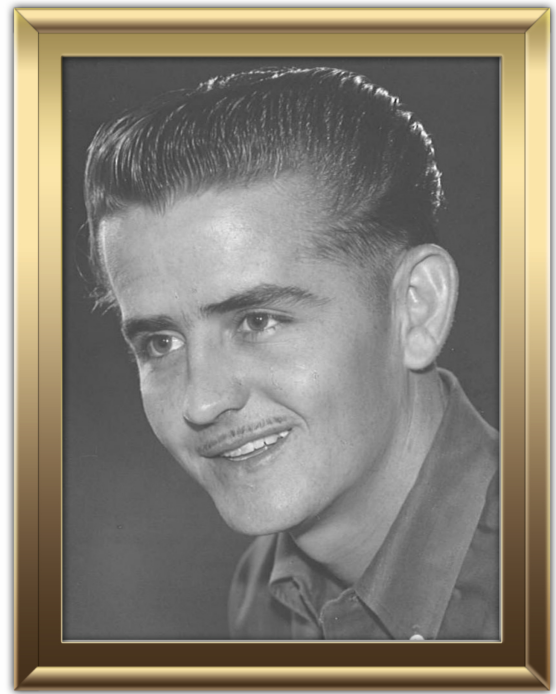

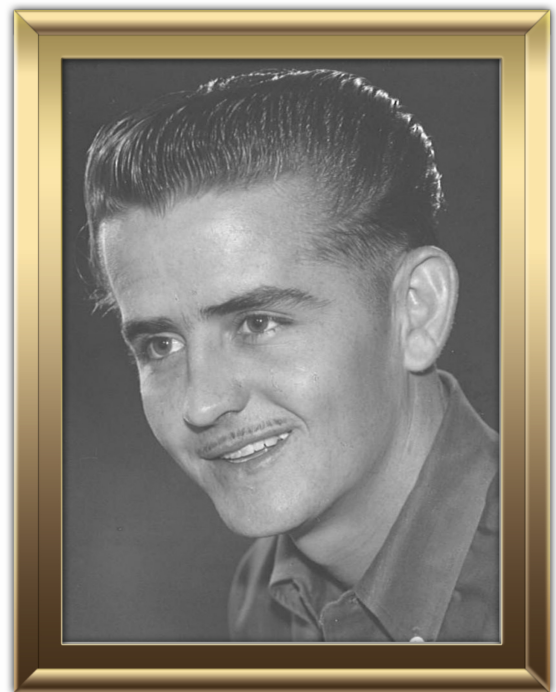
